A3047 Scorrier roundabout

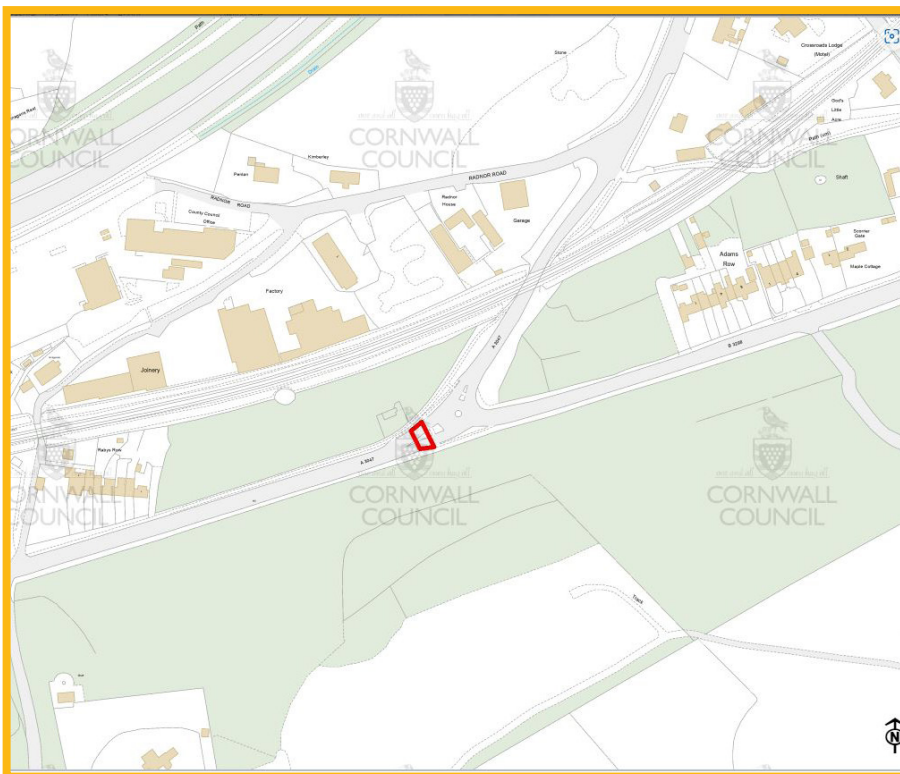
As part of our planned drainage improvement works, three-way traffic lights will be in place along A3047 on the Scorrier roundabout, from Monday 29 January to Friday 9 February.

Works will be carried out between 8.00 am and 5.00 pm, Monday to Friday. However, it may be necessary for us to work over the weekend to complete the scheme as quickly as possible.

The traffic management arrangements will be in place 24 hours a day for the scheme's duration. To minimise disruption, we will have marshals on site to manually operate the traffic lights between 07.00 am and 7.00 pm while the teams are on site. Priority will be given to road users exiting the A30 to reduce congestion and delays.

To give our workforce a safe working zone and protect road users we need to implement these measures.

Please be assured we will make every effort to minimise the impact to the local community.

What works are taking place?

The work involves replacing the existing culvert which has become damaged. These scheme will improve the capacity and efficiency of the highway drainage systems in this location.

Access arrangements

Suitable barrier systems will be installed to provide safe pedestrian access while the works take place.

Please be aware of the following hazards while the work is taking place.

- Uneven road surface where the old surface has been removed
- Raised manhole, gullies, and other service boxes
- Temporary storage of machinery and vehicles

Emergency access will be maintained at all times.
